Itinerary

The journey begins in Buenos Aires, where you should get to on your own.

This is a general plan of the expedition, the route may vary depending on the weather and ice conditions.

Day 1

Upon your arrival at the Buenos Aires airport, you will be

transferred to a hotel. Your 1-night stay at the hotel is included in the price of the program.

Day 2

In the morning, you will be taken to the airport for

the charter flight to Ushuaia, the southernmost city on Earth. Ushuaia is located in south Argentina, surrounded by the majestic Andes Mountains.

Embarkation to the ship will take place in the afternoon.

You will meet the ship's crew and expedition's members during a





Your journey to Antarctica begins by crossing the widest

and deepest strait on Earth. In the narrowest part, the width of the Drake Passage is 820 km, and the depth in some parts can reach 5 km

Days at sea are the perfect time to observe seabirds and

mammals from aboard the ship. Lectures from experts in glaciology, marine biology, history, and geology are waiting for you. You will learn about the history of Antarctic exploration, the origin of glaciers, and the flora and fauna of the White Continent.

Also, during these days, you can relax and use various

services on board. Visit a spa or a gym, check out a library filled with thematic books, or admire the stunning ocean views from your cabin balcony.

Day 4

These days you will explore the Antarctic Peninsula, the

most accessible part of the continent of Antarctica. The mild climate attracts all representatives of Antarctic wildlife here. On shore you will approach huge colonies of penguins, and at sea you can meet whales and leopard seals.

One of the days you will pass through the Lemaire

Channel, which is considered to be the most photogenic place in Antarctica. The narrow sea passage is framed by mountains and sparkling glaciers. Leopard seals and crabeater seals rest on the passing flat ice floes, and the shores are inhabited by penguins. Orcas and humpback whales often accompany the ship.

Day 5

The South Shetland Archipelago are sub-Antarctic islands

where the flora and fauna are markedly different from the rest of Antarctica due to higher temperatures. Most of the islands were discovered by expeditions of fur seal hunters in the early 19th century.

On zodiac expedition boats, you will enter the picturesque

submerged caldera of Deception Volcano and see the abandoned whaling stations on the island. Black volcanic beaches are favored by penguins, sea elephants, fur, crabeater, and Weddell seals. They are not afraid of humans at all and can be approached at a fairly close distance.

Day 6

These days the ship will take a return course to Ushuaia

through the already familiar Drake Passage. You can relax in the bar on board and exchange impressions with other cruise participants.

The captain's bridge is also always open for you. In the

evening you will enjoy a gala dinner with the captain, officers, and expedition team.

Day 7

In the morning, the ship will pass through the Beagle

Channel and call at the port of Ushuaia. After breakfast, you will say goodbye to the expedition team and the ship's crew and disembark. Then, a transfer to the airport for departure to Buenos Aires will be organized.

Accomodation at the trip

A 15% prepayment is needed to make a reservation. The final payment of 85% is paid 65 days before the start of the cruise.

Rates depend on the date, cruise duration, and cabin type selected. The price is per person with double occupancy in a cabin.

Ship's description

SH Vega and SH Diana are new 5-star expedition ships built in Finland's famous Helsinki Shipyard in 2022 and 2023. They are equipped with icestrengthened hulls and extra-large stabilizers.

A small number of guests – 152 on SH Vega and 192 on SH Diana – provide a friendly, informal atmosphere aboard as well as dynamic activities of the ships.

All public areas have fireplaces and panoramic windows. You can admire the Antarctic scenery from anywhere on board.

Onboard facilities: club lounge with 24-hour food service, observation lounge equipped for lectures and live music evenings, outdoor infinity pool, sauna with hot tubs with panoramic ocean views, SPA, gym, main restaurant, basecamp, library, and laboratory.

FAQ

What to bring with me

You will be given a branded waterproof and windproof expedition jacket, and high expedition rubber boots will be provided during sea walks and landings.

Clothing:

- waterproof pants for boat landings and landwalks (Gore-Tex and similar membrane fabrics are preferred. Wear them over your regular pants)
- thermal underwear (2 sets)
- thermal socks (3 pairs)
- shirts and T-shirts
- jeans or other comfortable pants (several pairs)
- turtlenecks (suitable for wearing under a warm sweater and for wearing on board)
- wool or fleece sweaters
- dressy clothes (for the welcome dinner and farewell cocktail with the captain)
- warm mittens and thin gloves (2 pairs)
- warm hat to protect your head and ears
- warm scarf

The price includes full board meals on the ship and an open bar (tea, coffee, soft drinks and alcoholic beverages, except premium brands). You will also enjoy a welcome cocktail with the captain and crew, a farewell gala dinner, and 24-hour cabin service.
